- v) The National Examination Council of Tanzania (NECTA) should verify certificates from foreign examination bodies for Ordinary or Advanced level education;
- vi) Candidates with unclassified degrees should attach an official GPA count from the respective University;
- vii) Applicants who were once employed in the public service should state the organization they worked with and why they were terminated from the public service;
- viii) A signed application letter should be written in English and Addressed to the Deputy Principal – Planning, Finance and Administration, Mkwawa University College of Education, P.O. Box 2513, Iringa.
- ix) Deadline for application is 3rd September, 2024;
- x) Only shortlisted candidates will be informed on the date of interview and;
- xi) Presentation of forged certificates and other information will necessitate to legal action.
- xii) Applicants for Assistant Lecturers posts should have a consistency career progression in his/her relevant area of specialization from Bachelors to Master's degree.
